



SkyCamp General Program Information

SkyCamp is 5 half-days of instructor led activities, age-appropriate SkyRobics, open jumping, Dodgeball, and new this year – Warrior Course! all incorporating the fun and excitement of Sky Zone.

Activities/Rotations

Each day at SkyCamp, your child will participate in open-jump time on the Sky Zone courts, a variety of games, both on and off the court, and age-appropriate SkyRobics sessions (focus on FUN). Each child will receive lunch and a beverage. We will also do arts and craft activities along with science projects.

Lunch

Lunch will be provided to each camper daily at 12:30pm. If your child has specific food allergies, be sure that this is indicated appropriately in your registration form (must be completed and turned in to Sky Zone staff in order to attend the program.). It is the parent's responsibility to make sure the Sky Zone staff is aware of your child's allergies. Campers are welcome to bring in their own lunches/snacks if preferred.

Personal Belongings

Remember to label all items brought to the program. Encourage your child to be responsible for their belongings. Sky Zone, the Camp Program and Sky Zone/SkyCamp staff will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Sign In/Out

All children are expected to check in with the SkyCamp staff immediately upon arrival at Sky Zone. **Parents must sign their child in & out every day with their full signature, and the specific time of drop off/pick up.** Children/Parents who do not abide by this policy are subject to dismissal from the program. Children will only be released to those individuals designated on the participation form. Again, for the protection and safety of the children, **ALL** authorized persons **MUST** be prepared to show picture identification card before a child can be released.

Early/Late Arrival Policy

Check-in for SkyCamp is at 8:30am every morning- NO EARLIER. Parents will be charged a \$15 fee the first hour after 1pm and \$25 for each additional 30 minutes, after the first hour. The late pickup fee is due at the time of pickup or before the participant returns to camp.

Illness and Exclusion Criteria

If a child becomes ill at the SkyCamp Program, SkyCamp instructors/moderators will notify the parent. Children who are ill must be picked up immediately and be kept home until they are recovered. A child must be fever free for twenty-four hour before returning back to the program. If a child develops a contagious disease, please inform us immediately.

Procedures for Handling Medical Emergencies

In the event of a medical emergency, the program director will be notified, as well as the parents. A certified person will give First Aid as soon as possible (if it is within the scope of our training). In most cases, the injured person should not be moved. In the event more than First Aid is needed, the staff will call 911. In the event that the parent or guardian cannot be reached, the employee, having immediate supervision, should check parent's emergency authorization for instructions on treatment of child. If child needs to go to the hospital, staff will take the health

history and emergency authorization with the injured child to the hospital or send it with the paramedics. A Sky Zone staff member will accompany the injured child to the hospital. After the immediate emergency has passed, a written statement and the proper SkyCamp forms will be filled out. Sky Zone management is trained in CPR.

Supervision

SkyCamp will hold a 1 to 13 staff to student ratio.

Waivers

All campers are required to have a waiver completed by their parent or legal guardian. Waivers must be done electronically.

Jump Socks

All campers must be given a pair of jump socks during check-in, on the first day of camp. If camper misplaces, or forgets to bring back their socks, then it will be an additional \$3 for a new pair.

Reschedule/Cancellation Policy

Parents are welcome to change Camp Sessions if needed. If parents decide to cancel their Session completely, they MUST give a 7 day notice, in order to receive their FULL refund. If they cancel within 7 days of the first day of camp, their payment will be forfeited.



Program Participant and Member Behavior Policy Statement

Sky Zone must have rules governing behavior in order to assure everyone's safety and enjoyment. Participants are expected to behave at all times. This can be accomplished by them showing respect to all other participants and staff, refrain from using abusive language, from causing bodily harm, or showing disrespect for equipment, supplies and facilities. If inappropriate behavior is displayed, guidelines will be set-up to correct the behavior. Sky Zone reserves the right to warn, suspend, or dismiss a program participant or member from our programs and facilities upon the following conditions:

- **If their behavior poses a threat to themselves or others**
- **If they require an inordinate amount of attention from the staff, thereby causing inadequate levels of supervision for the remainder of the participants or members**
- **If their behavior is deemed to be inappropriate**
- **For any reason within the discretion of Sky Zone/SkyCamp management.**
- **Inappropriate behavior of the parents or authorized escort.**

Parents/guardians are required to follow the "Behavior Code of Conduct" as well, and could be responsible for the suspension or removal of participants.

In the event that suspension or dismissal is deemed necessary at the discretion of Sky Zone management and/or SkyCamp Director, the parents will be notified personally. The day of such action will be the last day the child is allowed to attend.

Note: Depending on the severity of the situation, a participant may be suspended from the program for one-year, or permanently, prior to the first suspension. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GRANTED FOR SUSPENDED PROGRAM DAYS.**
